## **Honorable Tony Payton**

Honorable Tony Payton served the Pennsylvania State House of Representatives for 6 years, representing Philadelphians of the 179th Legislative district. Elected in 2007, Mr. Payton served on the Health and Human Services, Professional Licensure, Transportation and State Government committees. He introduced legislation to create the Pennsylvania Youth Commission and authored the REACH Scholarship Initiative. The Philadelphia Tribune named him one of the most influential African Americans in 2007.



#### Teresa Sneed

Teresa Sneed stands as the Founder, President, and Chief Executive Officer of National Family Justice (NFJ). This transformative nonprofit organization is dedicated to safeguarding children, revolutionizing family courts, and fortifying families across the United States. With an unyielding commitment to justice. child welfare, and constitutional parental rights, Teresa passionately leads NFJ's mission to create trauma-informed systems that prioritize safe shared parenting and enhance the well-being of families.



## Greg Fellerman
